

FMCSA Systems Release Notice

June 29 and 30, 2008

Upgrades to Central Systems (EMIS, L&I, MCMIS, and SAFER) were released on June 29, 2008. Updates to Field Systems (Aspen, CAPRI, CaseRite, SAFETYNET, and UFA) were released on June 30, 2008 and can be downloaded from the Information Systems Web site (<http://infosys.fmcsa.dot.gov/>). **Note: A script was distributed to all SAFETYNET sites for applying this update. FMCSA Technical Support will provide a notice when this update has been placed in all SAFETYNET "mailboxes".**

Note: Effective January 1, 2009, MCMIS will only accept uploads from CAPRI version 6.6.3 or above.

FMCSA Central Systems

The following updates were released on June 29, 2008.

EMIS (Enforcement Management Information System)

The following changes were implemented:

1) Overall Enhancements

- Issues that resulted in "page not found" messages and buttons with images being "grayed out" have been resolved.
- Changes will be made in some SANDOG letters.

L&I (Licensing & Insurance)

The following changes were implemented:

1) Overall Enhancements

- Actions against Mexican OP-2 carriers will be imposed for Safety Audit refusals.
- OP-1 (MX) and OP-2 Authority will be reinstated following the processing of Expedited Action Suspensions.
- A change will be made to letters generated by L&I.

MCMIS (Motor Carrier Management Information System)

The following changes were implemented:

1) Overall Enhancements

- Certain passenger motor carriers will be included on FMCSA's SafeStat A/B list.

- Mexican OP-1 carriers that have committed any one of the 7 most serious violations, as defined by FMCSA, will be removed.
- Since the launch of the FMCSA Portal, MCMIS users have had the option of making assignments either in MCMIS or through the Portal. Effective with this release, the assignment functionality in MCMIS will be disabled and all Enforcement users will make assignments using the current standard approach provided through the FMCSA Portal.
- An earlier “Page Not Found” error that occurred when pointing to archived inspections will be corrected.
- Letters generated by MCMIS will be modified.
- Modifications that address earlier issues with carriers not being placed in the New Entrant Program will be made.

SAFER (Safety and Fitness Electronic Records)

The following changes were implemented:

1) Overall Enhancement

- Validation of the federal identification number in UCR records will be implemented.
- Migration of the production server will be supported.
- The SAFER Company Safety Profile service will be updated with a new URL.

FMCSA Field Systems
